Deadline! Your Response must be **filed and served** within **60 days** of the date this Summons is published: May 30, 2026. If you do not file and serve your *Response* or a *Notice of Appearance* by the deadline:

- No one has to notify you about other hearings in this case, and
- The court may approve the requests in the Petition without hearing your side (called a *default judgment*).

Follow these steps:

1. **Read** the *Petition* and any other documents that were filed at court with this *Summons*. Those documents explain what the other party is asking for.
2. **Fill out** a *Response* on this form (*check the Response that matches the Petition*):
 FL Divorce 211, *Response to Petition about a Marriage*

3. **Serve** (give) a copy of your *Response* to the person who filed this *Summons* at the address below, and to any other parties. You may use certified mail with return receipt requested. For more information on how to serve, read Superior Court Civil Rule 5.
