Per Election Code 12102

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a general Municipal (DISTRICTS 1, 3, and 5) Election will be held in the City of Madera, County of Madera, State of California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the following Madera Offices:

- One (1) Councilmember Seat (District 1) - Full Term of Four Years
- One (1) Councilmember Seat (District 3) - Full Term of Four Years
- One (1) Councilmember Seat (District 5) - Full Term of Four Years

Madera County election polling places will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, Election Day.

Candidate qualifications for office, before pulling nomination documents: must be 18 years old or older, reside within the City of Madera, within District 1, 3, or 5 and be a registered voter.

Candidates are strongly encouraged to make an appointment with the Madera County Clerk-Recorder, Elections Division Office to obtain nomination documents by calling (559) 675-7720 or toll-free at (800)435-0509. Additional information is located on their website, www.VoteMadera.com/candidate-campaign-information/running-for-office/ Candidates are encouraged to call as early as possible to ensure candidacy nomination paperwork is completed before the filing deadline.

The nomination period opens Monday, July 13, 2026 and ends Friday, August 7, 2026 at 5 p.m. If an eligible incumbent does not file nomination documents by August 7, 2026 at 5 p.m., the filing period is extended for that office for five calendar days until August 12, 2026 at 5 p.m. for any person other than the incumbent.

If no one, or only one person, is nominated for any elected office, appointment to such elective office may be made as prescribed by the California Elections Code Section 10229.
